MA in Heritage Management is delighted to announce its scholarship programmes for this year.

MA in Heritage Management is a unique collaboration between the worlds of Archaeology (University of Kent, Canterbury with leading heritage management projects) and Business (Athens University of Economics and Business with one of the top 30 MBAs internationally). Courses include Education and Archaeology, Archaeological Site Management and Planning, Human Resources Management for Cultural organisations and Strategic Planning, Public Archaeology, Tourism Marketing, Project Management and others. All courses are taught in English, at or close to the archaeological site of Eleusis (home of the most famous mystic cults of antiquity), 10 km away from Athens, Greece. Students at the end of their studies receive two titles: one from Kent and one from AUEB. Fees are the same for both EU and non EU students at 7.500 Euros.

There are four scholarship programmes that students are welcome to apply for.

A Fulbright scholarship for a US student, a number of Stavros Niarchos scholarships for students from developing countries, a UniKent scholarship for students of all backgrounds and the Odossaki Foundation scholarship for students of Greek origin.
